What: This is an opportunity for you to visit the offices of your Senators and Representatives to educate them on the success of local homeless assistance programs and to call on them to support initiatives which will allow communities to continue making progress towards ending homelessness. We will share strategies for having effective visits with a Congressional office prior to your meetings at:

- A Half-Day Advocacy Training Institute: *Courting Congress: Beginner to Intermediate Advocacy and Lobbying*;
- A tenant and consumer advocate's workshop: *Voices Cary: Consumers and Tenants Advocating*;
- And at the "Advocacy Day Information Table" located at the conference by the registration desk.

Where: We will begin the day at the Hyatt Hotel (where the conference takes place). Throughout the conference there will be opportunities for participants from each state to meet, discuss Capitol Hill visits and coordinate going to Capitol Hill as a group for the visits.
