




#### **Duration of Homelessness**




# **Current Sleeping Space**









# Other facts about Camden County's Homeless Population:

- 20% served in the military
- 31% were concerned about where they were staying
- 9% were in foster care or out of home placement as a youth
- 32% did <u>not</u> have a photo ID
- 46% have been incarcerated at one time
- 68% of those incarcerated were discharged into homelessness
- 41% have been hospitalized for medical reasons
- 53% of those hospitalized were discharged into homelessness
- 38% received in-patients mental health or addiction treatment
- 61% who received treatment were discharged into homelessness
