Homeless System Components



Outreach/Engagement	 Connecting with those experiencing homelessness to ensure they access the services they are elgible for
Centralized/Coordinated Intake	A single process to field requests for assistance and screen for the most appropriate program
Prevention	Provide limited financial assistance for those at risk of homelessness
Diversion	 Assist those requesting emergency shelter in identifying alternative shelter arrangements through their support network
Emergency Shelter	 Provide temporary emergency shelter to those with no other shelter alternatives
Transitional Housing	Temporary housing available for 18-24 months provided to targeted

Rapid Re-Housing

• Temporary finanical assistance and support services provided for up to 18 months in permanent scattered site units

populations requiring intensive services in a structured setting

Permanent Supportive Housing

• Long term financial assistance and support services in permanent housing

Permanent Housing

• Leasing based housing in the community
