



Homeless System Components



Outreach/Engagement

- Connecting with those experiencing homelessness to ensure they access the services they are eligible for

Centralized/Coordinated Intake

- A single process to field requests for assistance and screen for the most appropriate program

Prevention

- Provide limited financial assistance for those at risk of homelessness

Diversion

- Assist those requesting emergency shelter in identifying alternative shelter arrangements through their support network

Emergency Shelter

- Provide temporary emergency shelter to those with no other shelter alternatives

Transitional Housing

- Temporary housing available for 18-24 months provided to targeted populations requiring intensive services in a structured setting

Rapid Re-Housing

- Temporary financial assistance and support services provided for up to 18 months in permanent scattered site units

Permanent Supportive Housing

- Long term financial assistance and support services in permanent housing

Permanent Housing

- Leasing based housing in the community
