#### The Bergen County Housing, Health and Human Services Center

#### Did you know....?

The Bergen County Housing, Health and Human Services Center is a one-stop location at 120 South River Street in Hackensack serving individual men and women who are homeless or precariously housed and others who require assistance to be connected to care management, needed services and housing.

The Center is a 27,516 square foot building with showers, bathrooms and laundry facilities with shelter for up to 90 individuals and additional temporary sit-up shelter space available during the winter months to ensure that no person need spend the night on the street during the coldest time of the year.

The Center is open 24 hours a day year-round with breakfast served for shelter guests and lunch and dinner available for those in the community who cannot afford a meal. Dinner is provided by local civic and faith communities.

The Center's goal is to place individuals in housing and provide the support services needed to ensure that the placement is permanent. Onsite services include professional evaluation of client needs, development of individualized treatment plans, care management, medical screening, mental health and substance abuse counseling, legal aid, veteran's services, HIV/AIDS counseling, Alcoholics Anonymous and nutrition services.

The Center assists with job readiness training and placement, employment counseling, application for public assistance such as Medicaid and welfare/benefits applications, and homeless prevention services including emergency rent, utility and food vouchers.

The Center's medical care is provided through an affiliation with the Bergen County Sheriff's Department located across the street from the Center.
