


PIT SUMMARY 2024 HUDSON

Commissioned by the New Jersey Housing and Mortgage Finance Agency, New Jersey's annual Point-in-Time (PIT) Count of the Homeless provides a statewide snapshot and important demographic insights on persons experiencing homelessness, with the goal of allocating housing resources and services to prevent and end homelessness.

Yearly Comparsion of Total Homeless Population

Total Homeless Population by County



1,168 persons were experiencing homelessness in Hudson County on January 23rd, 2024.
27% increase in homelessness between 2023 and 2024.
956 PEOPLE WERE SHELTERED
212 PEOPLE WERE UNSHELTERED
60% MAN (BOY IF CHILD) 36% WOMAN (GIRL IF CHILD)
18% CHILDREN UNDER 18 24% ADULTS AGES 55+

49% REPORTED ONE OR MORE DISABILITIES




250 WERE CHRONICALLY HOMELESS (21%)




87 WERE VICTIMS OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE **(7%)**
