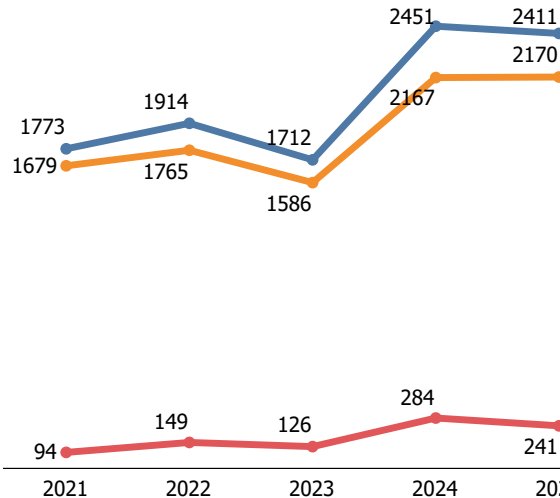

### Yearly Comparision of Total Homeless Population



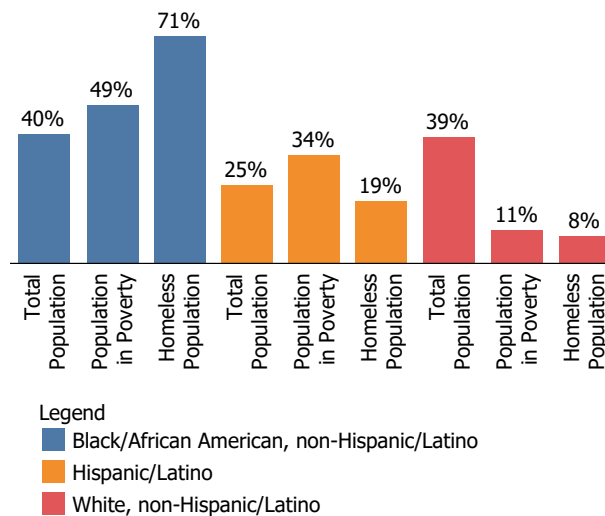
